

The Aces High Aviation Poker Run benefits the Long Island 2 Day Walk to Fight Breast Cancer.

Registration is \$30 and includes one poker hand (5 cards). Additional hands may be purchased for \$10 each. All participants must have a separate registration and poker hand. The suggested fundraising amount for each registrant is \$500. When you register you will receive a personal ID number and information that will allow you to track your fundraising progress and for your friends and family to make online donations online.

To allow for weather considerations, the Poker Run will take place between May 1 –15. Pilots will pick up a playing card at their base airport and four additional airports in CT and LI. During registration, you may choose up to four additional poker hands, for a total of five. Each 5-card poker hand purchased will be a different color and cannot be mixed and matched to create hands. Only one card per participant may be picked up (for each hand) at each participating airport.

Awards will be given for a combination of the best poker hand and total funds raised. The Grand Prize will be awarded to the participant who has the best hand and who has raised the most money (over \$500). Winners will be announced on May 15th during the Aviation Open House.

Pilots must comply with all FAA Rules & Regulations. No refunds for inability to complete Poker Run. Poker hands must be received by 12 p.m. on May 15th at Mid Island ISP (631-588-5400). Pilots are responsible for all costs pertaining to their flights including any landing fees. In the event of a tie, an additional card will be picked by each participant until the tie is broken.
