

# G1000 Proficiency Course



The G1000 is an integrated avionics system, an all-glass flight deck that represents flight instrumentation, location, navigation, communication, and identification data on large format, high resolution displays – putting all flight-critical information at the pilot’s fingertips.

Our G1000 course consists of ground school, a workshop and Redbird proficiency flight. The course is approximately one and one half days. The first day is approximately 6 hours of ground school including a hands on workshop for scenario based training. You will learn to enter, edit and perform various functions of the G1000 and will exercise your skills to develop proficiency with this technology.

You will complete the course in the Redbird AATD Simulator on a one hour, takeoff to touchdown, flight scenario.

If you own a G1000 aircraft and would prefer to do this part in the aircraft, one hour of CFI time will be included. Additional training is dependent on the pilot’s level of proficiency, currency, and intended flight [example short or long cross countries or actual IMC flight].
