Safety First:

Over the years we have noticed that some pilots get an initial check out with MIAS and then continue to rent the same aircraft type for the next ten years. While this is great and a safe practice to fly one aircraft type, they may NEVER again fly with one of our instructors. As we have not mandated your BFR to be done with a Mid Island instructor, there are some renters that we never have the opportunity to fly with, many years after their initial check out.

In this environment with escalating insurance costs, it is mandatory that we make sure that all of our renters stay proficient. **The most important service we can do for our customers is to ensure their safety and the safety of their passengers.**

Our Mid Island Annual Flight Review (AFR) is now required prior to solo rental. You must have flown with a Mid Island flight instructor within the previous twelve calendar months in the performance of a BFR, new aircraft check-out or flight test.

If you have had such a flight in the past year, and many of you have, please show the dispatchers your logbook entry and they will update our computer records. If you are enrolled and actively pursuing a certificate or rating your instructor will advise you of your solo privileges.

The MIAS AFR will require a one hour flight. If your BFR is due soon, we'll add the one hour of ground to satisfy your FAA Biennial Flight Review requirement.

We want this flight to be a learning experience. Not night current? – schedule a night dual flight. Uncomfortable flying through Class B? – Schedule a dual cross-country through Kennedy airspace. You get the idea. Learning can be fun!
